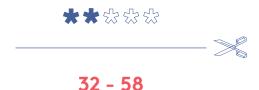

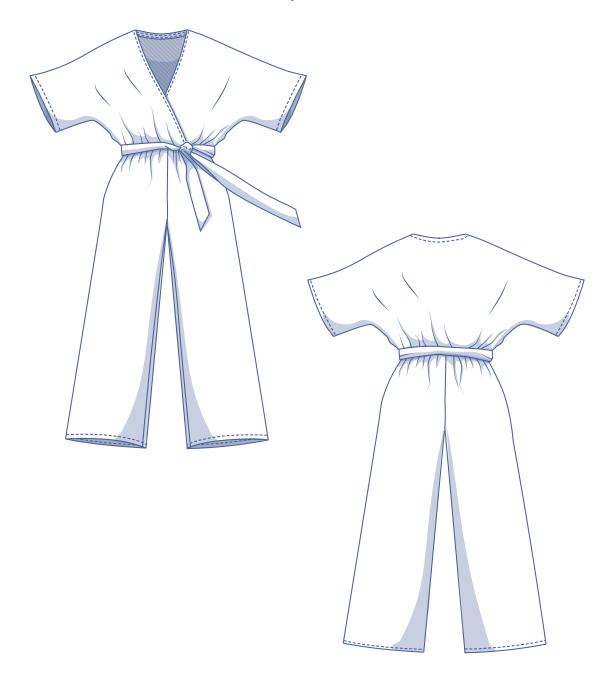


Riva by Fibre 400d



The Riva jumpsuit has a V-neck wrap top and shaped 3/4 sleeves. It features an elasticised waist and a belt.

The length of the trouser legs can be altered based on preference.

Chest (B): measure horizontally around the fullest part of the chest.

Hip (H): measure horizontally around the widest part of the lower body.

Compare the stated lengths to the measured or desired lengths. Lengthen or shorten the trouser legs, the top and/or the sleeves by cutting the pattern pieces at the indicated double lines and then spreading the pattern pieces out X cm from each other or overlapping them where needed. Make sure that the CF and CB lines and the side seams are always straight.

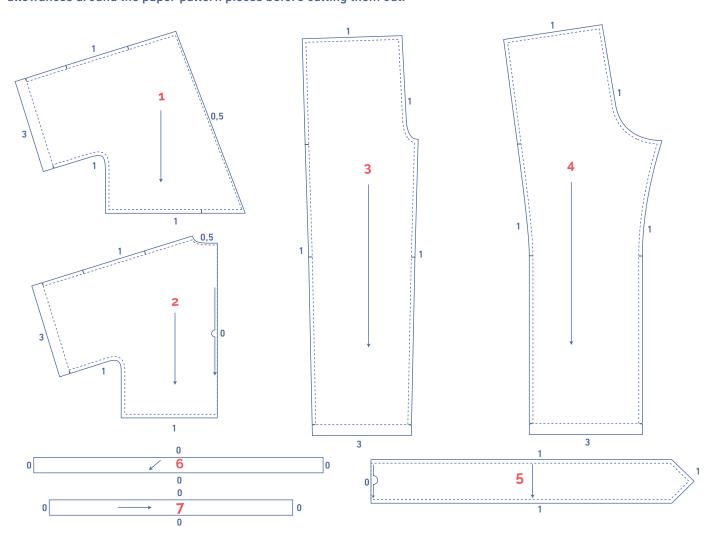
fabric advice



Make the Riva jumpsuit in medium-weight, woven fabric with a fluid drape. We used a viscose crepe in a striped print and a viscose twill in a striped print. Comprehensive information about the fabrics in the Fibre Mood collection can be found https://example.com/en/fabrics.

pattern pieces & seam allowances (in cm)

To sew the garment as described in the instructions, you must draw the illustrated seam allowances around the paper pattern pieces before cutting them out.



1. front: 2x

2. back: 1x on fabric fold

3. trouser front: 2x

4. trouser back: 2x

5. belt: 1x on fabric fold

6. neck bias tape: 1x, you will need to draw this yourself. Draw a rectangle with the following measurements

7. belt loops: 1x, you will need to draw these pattern pieces yourself. Draw a rectangle 2.5x24 cm.

- Nick the pattern paper and fabric at the places where a single vertical line (I) and double vertical lines (II) are indicated.
- Cut a small corner out of the fabric where a V notch is and on the finished hemline of pattern pieces 3 and 4.
- Cut a small corner (V notch) out of the pieces that lie on the fabric fold to mark the middle of these pieces.
- Mark the location of the snap indicated by an x by marking the centre with needle and thread (= basting thread).

sewing instructions

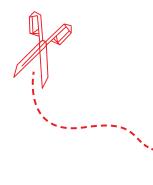


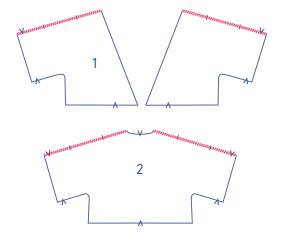
The method used to finish sewing the garment depends on the fabric used.

The pieces are always sewn together with the right sides of the fabric matching exactly, unless stated otherwise.



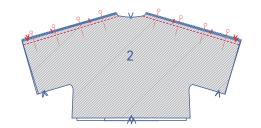

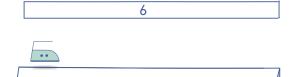




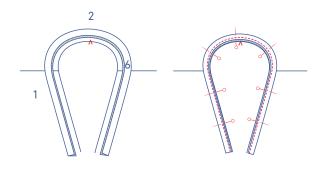
Finish the shoulder seams of the front (1) and back (2) using an overlock stitch.



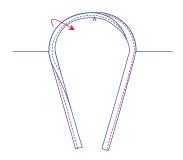
Pin and sew the shoulder seams together and press the seam open.



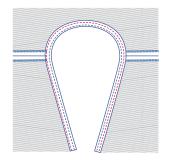
Press the neck bias tape (6) in half with the right side of the fabric turned outward.



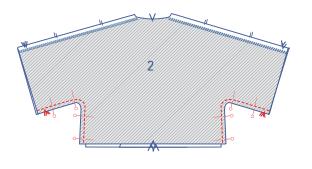
Pin both raw edges of the bias tape to the neckline along the right side of the work piece. Sew into place at 0.5 cm.



Fold the bias tape and the seam allowance out of the way and sew the bias tape into place at 2 mm from the seam through all the layers (= the bias tape + the seam allowance underneath) of fabric.

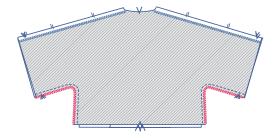


Fold the bias tape all the way over to the wrong side and sew it into place right next to the edge.

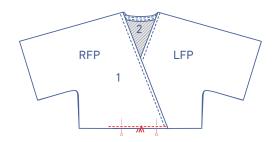

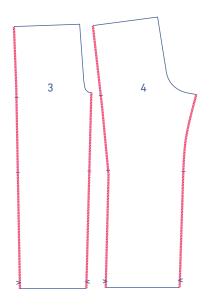
Pin and sew the underarm seams together.



Finish the raw edges together using an overlock stitch.

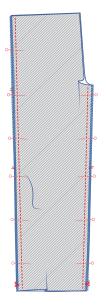


Pin the V notch that marks the CF of the RF to the matching V notch on the LF. Sew both pieces together, $0.5\ cm$ from the bottom.

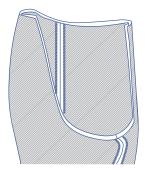

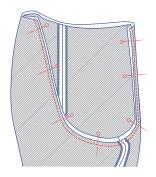
Finish the side and inseams of the trouser front (3) and trouser back (4) using an overlock stitch.



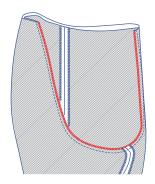
Pin and sew the side and inseams. You should now have two trouser legs. Press the seams open.



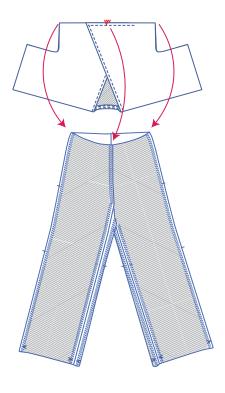
Slide both trouser legs into each other with the right sides faced together.



Pin and sew the crotch seam.

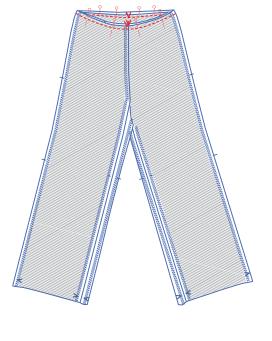


Finish both raw edges together using an overlock stitch.

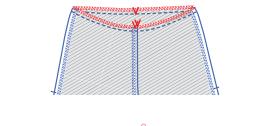

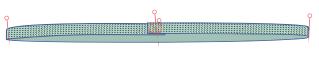
Slide the top into the trousers with the right sides turned towards each other. Continue until the waist seams of both pieces match perfectly.



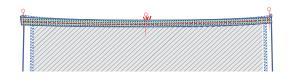
Pin and sew the top of the trousers to the bottom of the top, making sure that the nicks and side seams match perfectly.



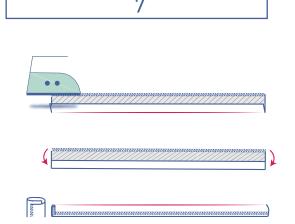
Finish the raw edges together using an overlock stitch.



Allow 3 cm of the ends of the elastic to overlap and sew. in place. Divide the elastic into 4 equal parts and pin each of these points.



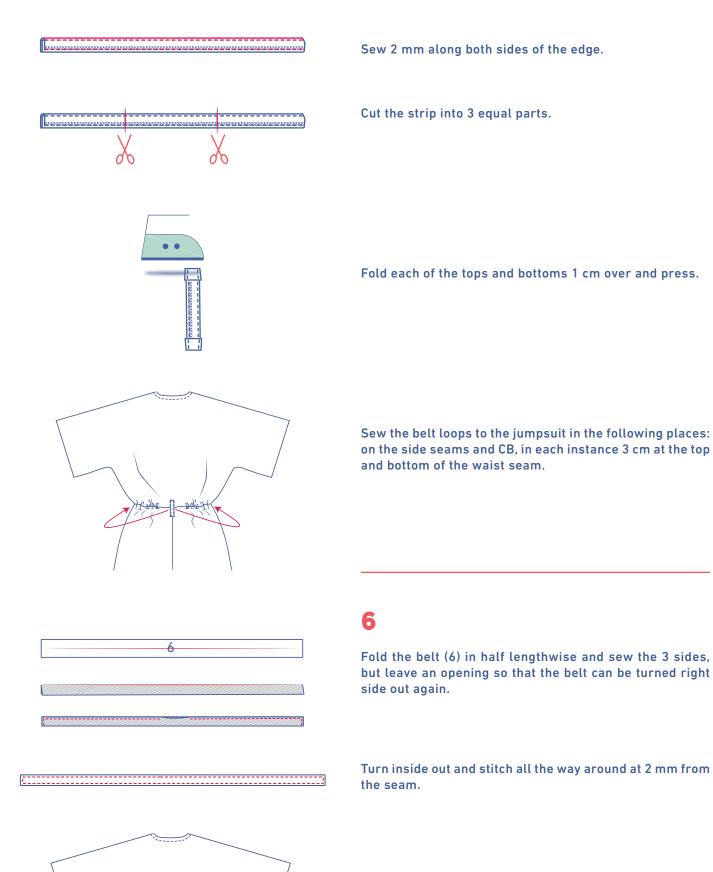
Use the same pins to pin the elastic to the seam allowance at the CF, CB and side seams. Stretch the elastic out and sew in place on the seam allowance.



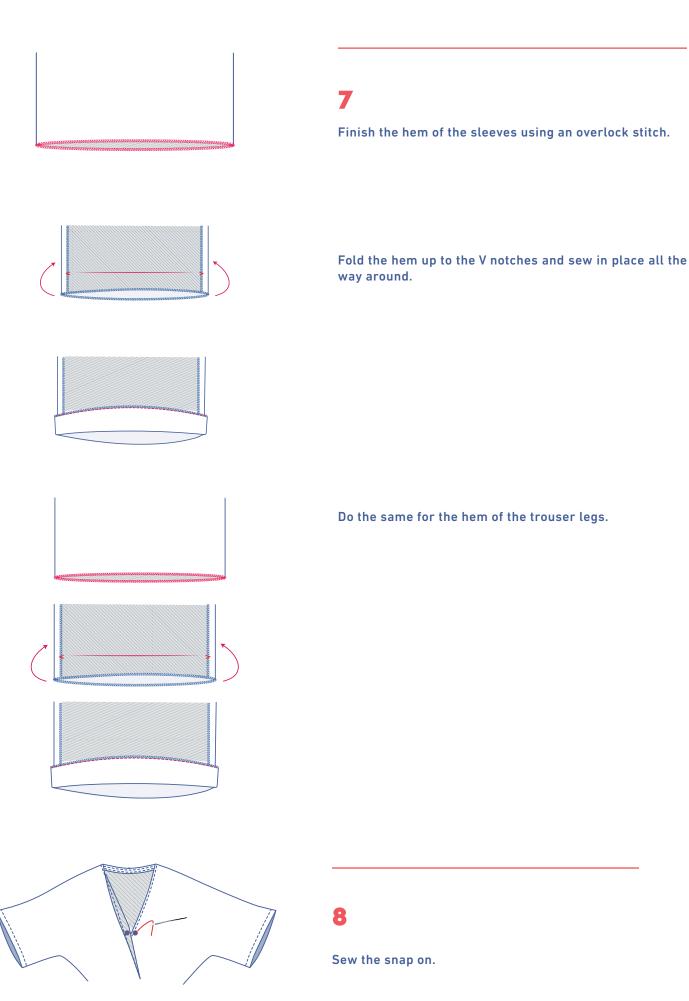

Finish 1 long side of the fabric strip for the belt loops (7) using an overlock stitch.

Fold the side that has not been overlocked 1 cm over to the wrong side and fold the finished side on top of this.



Thread the belt through the belt loops.
