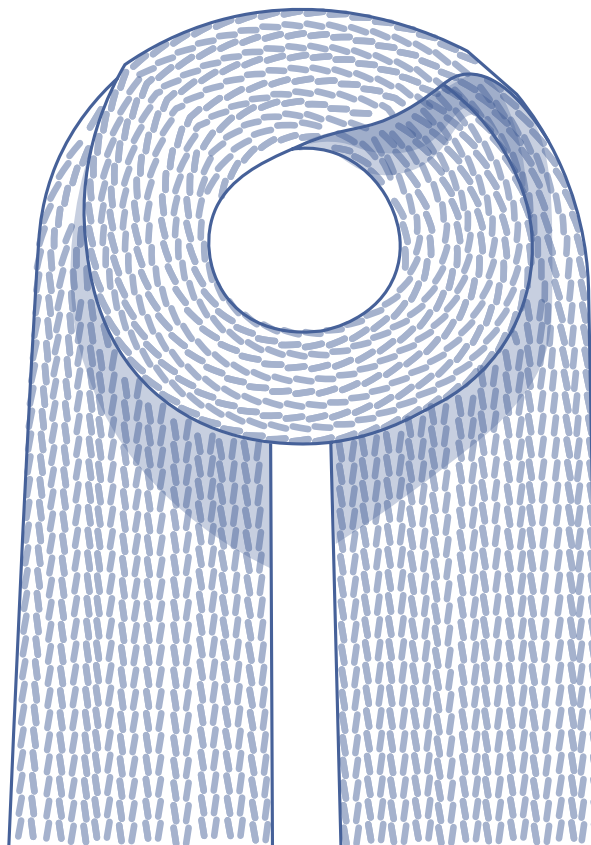


Bliss by Fibre ood

Your little person can set off for schoolsnug as a bug in a rug this winter with the Bliss scarf. An easy beginner project that's as fun as it is fast, all you have to do is knit long horizontal bands in a simple rib stitch. Have fun with colour combos and play with the width of the bands!



finished garment measurements (in cm)

length	100	110	120	130	140	150	170
width	20	20	20	20	20	20	20

supplies



- Knitting needles no. 5
- Yarns: Merino+ (Lang Yarns), colour 129 (pink), colour 111 (ochre), colour 10 (blue) and colour 187 (rust)

size	2	4	6	8	10	12	14
Merino+ colour 129 + 111	2+2	3+3	4+4	5+5	5+5	6+6	6+6
Merino+ colour 10 + 187	2+2	3+3	4+4	5+5	5+5	6+6	6+6

Merino+ (100% virgin wool): one 50-g ball contains approximately 90 m of yarn.

stitch used

Rib stitch 2/2:

Purl 2, knit 2, repeat. For the return row, knit the knits and purl the purls.

knitting instructions



2/4/6/8/10/12/14 years

1

Cast 64 st on using no. 5 needles. Use the knitted cast-on.

2

Knit coloured horizontal bands (you decide how) in rib stitch 2/2 to a total height of 100/110/120/130/140/150/170 cm. Always start and end your row with 1 purl stitch.

3

Tuck in all loose ends.
